



**Guidelines for Inter-Departmental Sports Tournament 2023-2024**  
**being organized by General Administration Department, Govt. of NCT**  
**of Delhi**

- 1) The General Administration Department is organising Athletics, Badminton and Table Tennis under various age categories (Men and Women); Cricket (Men) and Tug-of-War (Men and women) events.
- 2) These games will be organised w.e.f. **10<sup>th</sup> July 2023 to 16<sup>th</sup> July 2023**.
- 3) The Athletics, Badminton, Table Tennis and Tug-of-War events will take place at Thyagraj Stadium, near INA, New Delhi. Cricket matches will be played, primarily, at Bharat Nagar Cricket Ground, near Laxmi Bai College, Ashok Vihar, Delhi - 110052. If need arises, then the matches can also be played at Vikas Puri Cricket Ground and Jheel Khurenja Cricket Ground.
- 4) Tentatively, the reporting time for Athletics and Tug-of-War events will be at 6.00 pm whereas the reporting time for Badminton and Table Tennis activities will be at 3.00pm. The exact timings will be made available once the exact schedule / fixtures are drawn.
- 5) The Cricket matches will be played in the morning as well as in the evening. For morning match, the reporting time will be at **7.00 am** whereas the reporting time for evening match will be at **3.00pm**.
- 6) The schedule of events/fixtures will be made available in due course once the entries are received from the officers/officials in respect of individual events and from various departments in respect of team games.
- 7) One player is allowed to participate in only one game out of Athletics, Badminton & Table Tennis and upto 2 events in that game under his/her own age category. Besides this, one player of a particular department will participate only in one team game. A player who intends to participate in individual game is also eligible to participate in team game provided he/she is selected by the department concerned in its team.
- 8) The doubles' partner in Badminton and Table Tennis should be from the same department and of the same age group.
- 9) All the participants will be provided Participation Certificates.
- 10) All the winners; runners' up and 3<sup>rd</sup> place holder will be awarded cash prize of Rs. 5,100/-; Rs. 3,100/- & Rs. 2,100/- each respectively in all the games.
- 11) The entries are to be submitted by the individual players, in the prescribed proforma, only in respect of Athletics; Badminton and Table Tennis whereas the entries in respect of team games of Cricket and Tug-of-War will be sent by the department concerned on their letter head indicating name; designation; place of posting etc. of the concerned player. The entries in respect of Cricket and Tug-of-war will be submitted by the departments only after obtaining the prior approval of their respective Competent Authority. The department will also nominate a nodal officer in respect of each team game for proper liaisoning and coordination.



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12) If any department wishes to nominate its Cricket teams more than the allotted quota, then it should intimate General Administration Department, latest by 15.06.2023 positively.

○ However, the decision on participation of extra teams beyond the allotted quota will be with General Administration Department.

13) The department concerned will declare its captain of the respective team at the time of submission of entry with the liberty to change the name of the captain at least 24 hours prior to the match scheduled.

14) Each player is required to participate in proper uniform of that game. The uniform as well as playing equipments will be arranged by the player/department itself at his / her own level except Shuttle Cocks, TT balls and Cricket balls.

15) The General Administration Department will provide coloured dresses to the finalists of the cricket team as well as to the officers' team for day / night T-20 match.

16) Each player will ensure himself/herself that he/she is physically fit to participate in these games. General Administration Department will not be responsible for any untoward incident or injury arising due to this Inter-Departmental Sports tournament 2023-24.

17) Each player will maintain proper decorum and discipline while participating in this tournament.

18) Any misbehaviour; indiscipline or any kind of breach will lead to disqualification of the player from these games including barring of his participation in any kind of games for the next 3 years.

19) In those departments, where the retirement age is beyond 60 years, such players will participate in the last age category of respective games.

20) General Administration Department reserves the rights to alter/relax/modify/add/delete any rule or clause of the respective games in the interest of players without assigning any reasons thereof.

21) The decision of the General Administration Department for these games will be final and binding upon the players.

22) The players participating in these tournaments will be treated "On Duty" on the actual day of his / her event.

23) Neither any TA/DA nor any compensatory off will be allowed on account of participation in these games.

24) Last date of submission of complete registration forms in respect of Athletics, Badminton & T.T. will be 26.6.2023 whereas the last date of submission of entries in respect of Cricket and Tug-of-War is 04.7.2023. The entries received in sports cell of General Administration Department beyond the stipulated date will not be entertained.

25) The entries in respect of Athletics; Badminton & T.T. will be entertained only if they are submitted in prescribed proforma. The entries in any other form or on plain paper will not be entertained.

26) All the participants should carry original identity card, mandatorily, at the venue at the time of participation.

27) There shall be minimum three participants in an event for conducting that event.

28) Referees/Umpire's decision shall be final and binding on the participants.



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29) Entry form is enclosed with these guidelines.

30) Any information regarding change of venue/dates/cancellation etc about the Inter Departmental Sports Tournament 2023-24 will be available on the official website of General Administration Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

**Rules and Regulations for Inter-Departmental Sports Tournament**  
**2023-2024 being organized by General Administration Department,**  
**Govt. of NCT of Delhi**

**BADMINTON:**

1. All players are required to participate in proper dress code meant for Badminton discipline.
2. All the matches upto pre-quarter final stage will be played with the plastic shuttlecocks, preferably Mavis brand which will be provided by General Administration Department.
3. All the matches from quarter finals onwards will be played with feather shuttlecock which will be provided by General Administration Department.
4. All the matches upto pre-quarter finals will comprise of set of 15 points each and best of three sets.
5. All the matches from quarter finals onwards will comprise of set of 21 points each and best of 3 sets.
6. The players are required to bring their own racquets, shoes etc. at their own cost to participate in these games. It is mandatory to wear non-marking badminton shoes to enter the courts
7. The decision of the Tournament Committee will be final on all points of facts, the Chief Referee will be the sole in-charge of all technical issues on point of law.
8. Every player has to report at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time of the match, otherwise walkover will be given to the opponent.
9. All the losing semi- finalists in all the age categories will be adjudged 3rd place holder and will be conferred cash prize of Rs. 2,100/- each.
10. The General Administration Department may consider giving consolation prizes in any age category to any number of players at its own level. The decision of General Administration Department will be final and binding upon all the players and Departments.
11. No food or eatables are allowed inside the arena before and after the match.

**TABLE TENNIS:**

1. All players are required to participate in proper dress code meant for TT discipline.
2. All the matches will be played with the 3 star ball which will be provided by General Administration Department.
3. All the matches will comprise of set of 11 points each and best of five sets.
4. The players are required to bring their own racquets; shoes etc. at their own cost to participate in these games. It is mandatory to wear non-marking TT shoes to enter the courts.
5. The decision of the Tournament Committee will be final on all points of facts, the Chief Referee will be the sole in-charge of all technical issues on point of law.
6. Every player has to report at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time of the match, otherwise walkover will be given to the opponent.

7. All the losing semi- finalists in all the age categories will be adjudged 3rd place holder and will be conferred cash prize of Rs. 2,100/- each.
8. The General Administration Department may consider giving consolation prizes in any age category to any number of players at its own level. The decision of General Administration Department will be final and binding upon all the players and Departments.
9. No food or eatables are allowed inside the arena before and after the match.

#### **ATHLETICS:**

1. All players are required to participate in proper dress code meant for Athletics discipline.
2. All the events will take place at synthetic athletics turf of Thyagraj Stadium in the evening. Hence, the players are expected to arrange proper shoes before participation so as to avoid any loss to the Government property.
3. The decision of the Tournament Committee will be final on all points of facts, the Chief Referee will be the sole in-charge of all technical issues on point of law.
4. Every player has to report at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time of the event, otherwise the player will be disqualified from participating in the event.
5. Since the summer season is at peak in the month of July; so the players are advised to get themselves medically checked and ensure that they are fit to participate in athletics events. If needed, they should carry their own energy drink or any other glucose water for hydration.

#### **CRICKET:**

1. All players are required to participate in proper dress code meant for Cricket discipline.
2. The matches will take place in the morning as well as in the evening as per the schedule which will be finalised in due course.
3. All the matches will be of T-20 format. For morning match, the reporting time of both the teams will be at 7.00am whereas the reporting time for evening match will be at 3.00pm. For final match, the reporting time will be 5.00pm as it is scheduled as Day/Night match.
4. All the matches upto semi-final stage will be played with the Red ball whereas the final match will be played with white ball.
5. For participating in Cricket matches, spikes shoes are not allowed.
6. The Cricket playing kit as well as wears to the finalist teams and to the team of the officers' will be provided by General Administration Department for playing final match of the tournament. The Cricket playing kit will be taken back from the teams once the matches are over. The decision of the Tournament Committee will be final on all points of facts, the Chief Umpire will be the sole in-charge of all technical issues on point of law.
7. Every player has to report at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time of the match, otherwise walkover will be given to the opponent.
8. The General Administration Department may consider giving consolation prizes to any number of players at its own level. The decision of General Administration Department will be final and binding upon all the players and Departments.



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**Tug of War:**

- O 1. The team will comprise of 10 players each. However only 8 players will play at a time.
- 2. Maximum combined weight for 8 players in men category will be 680 kg.
- 3. Maximum combined weight for 8 players in women category will be 560 kg.
- 4. The players are allowed to participate in general sports shoes without spikes.
- 5. The match will be decided on best of three pull each.

\*In Badminton and Table Tennis, separate matches will be played, for officials and officers, in the age category of 50-60 years only.

\*\* The doubles partners should be from the same department and of the same age category.

The rules and regulations, broadly, of the Inter-departmental sports Tournament 2023-24 are as under:-

- a) The duration of the proposed tournament (except cricket) shall be one week. The matches shall start from 03:00 PM onwards (except Athletics events). All Athletics events will take place after 6.00pm in floodlights. The exact schedule of the games will be released in due course.
- b) 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> position holders shall be rewarded with cash prizes of Rs.5,100/-; Rs.3,100/- & Rs.2,100/- respectively and a merit certificate. The cash award shall be given to all the team members in case of a team event and to both the players in doubles matches.
- c) In cricket, consolation prizes shall be given in the form of Man of the match (only for final); Man of the series; best batsman; best bowler; best all rounder; best fielder etc.
- d) An event shall be organized only if there are minimum three entries in that event.
- e) A player can participate only in one game of his/ her choice and maximum of two events in the specific age category of that game (except Cricket and Tug of war). He / she will have to give a declaration to this effect while submitting his / her entry.
- f) The cutoff date for determining age for participation in the above said tournaments shall be 01<sup>st</sup> July, 2023.
- g) Only the regular employees of GNCTD shall be allowed to participate in the events, including the regular employees of GNCTD on deputation in other Autonomous bodies of Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

h) Cricket event:

- i. The final match of the Cricket Tournament shall be organized as day / night T-20 match.
- ii. GAD shall select & field three teams including one team to be formed for the gazetted officers of those departments of GNCTD where the strength of department is less or where there is no possibility to select a whole team of 14 players.
- iii. The Directorate of Education is allowed to field upto five teams from their respective regions (one team per region) and Revenue department is allowed to field upto three teams. All other departments may field only one team of their respective department.

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● All Heads of the Departments/Offices are requested to bring the contents of this circular into the knowledge of their respective officers / officials; encourage them to participate in the said tournament and subsequently allow them to participate in the tournament. As regards the team games of Cricket and Tug of War, the departments are requested to send their willingness latest by 15.06.2023 to GAD, Delhi Secretariat at "[sgad@nic.in](mailto:sgad@nic.in)".

The department of the officer/official who desires to participate in the above events shall be considered from the department where the officer/official is physically working as on 15<sup>th</sup> June 2023.

Sh. Bhaskar Priyadarshi; Sh. Vivek Mishra and Sh. Atul Makker, Section Officers of GAD are the coordinating officers for the said tournament.

The detailed schedule of events and other guidelines relating to the above said tournament will follow in due course. Entries for participation in this tournament will be invited through a prescribed proforma which will be circulated shortly.
