

3. The scheme was again revised with the approval of the Cabinet vide its decision No.630 dated 29/06/2001. Accordingly the following modifications were made in the scheme vide order No.F.7 (14)/99-GAD/FF/6109 dated 06/11/2001.

- A) Secretary (GAD) is authorized to reimburse all the medical expenses in respect of the Delhi Based Freedom Fighters who are receiving pension from Government of Delhi and their spouses, undergoing treatment in the approved Hospitals who have accepted the arrangement for direct reimbursement up to Rupees One Lakh per annum for Freedom Fighter or his/her spouse on terms and conditions approved by government from time to time.
- B) All bills of hospitals/nursing homes shall be cleared as early as possible and in any case within 90 days of receipt in GAD
- C) All payment shall be made from the Head of Account from which pensions are disbursed to the Freedom Fighter, in the General Administration Department.
- D) In the case of major surgical procedures, Secretary (GAD) is authorized to advance up to 80% of estimated charges.
- E) So far the following Hospitals have accepted the proposal in principle for direct reimbursement:-
 - a) National Heart Institute, East of Kailash, New Delhi.
 - b) Sir Ganga Ram Hospital, Rajinder Nagar, New Delhi.
 - c) Sita Ram Bhartia Institute of Medical Research, Mehrauli, New Delhi.

 - h) Jeewan Hospital & Nursing Home, Jeewan Nagar, New Delhi.
 - i) Dharamshila Cancer Hospital & Research Centre, Vasundhara Enclave, Delhi.
 - j) Majecdia Hospital, Hamdard Nagar, New Delhi.
 - k) Khosla Hospital (Maharishi Ayurveda Aorgyadham), Shalimar Bagh, Delhi.

4. In the meeting dated 16.12.2010 of Freedom Fighters' Relief and Memorial Committee (FFFR&MC), the members requested for increase in Cashless limit (Direct payment to Hospitals) from Rupees One Lakh to Rupees Two Lakh and increase in the Super Specialty Hospitals. Similar request was also raised by the All India Freedom Fighters Sainik Sangh.

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These requests were examined by the Freedom Fighter Cell of Govt. of Delhi in consultation with the Finance, Health & Family Welfare & Law Departments. Accordingly, the Cabinet vide its decision No.1867 dated 22/02/2012 has approved inclusion of the following Hospitals in the empanelled list of hospitals for Freedom Fighters and their spouses.

10. Yasodha Super Specialty Hospital, H-1, Koshambi, Ghaziabad (UP).
11. Yasodha Hospital & Research Centre Ltd., III-M, Nehru Nagar, Ghaziabad (UP).

5. Further, the Cabinet vide its Decision No. 1867 dated 22/02/2012 also approved the Cashless limit of Rupees One Lakh to Rupees Two Lakh per annum for getting medical treatment from any of the empanelled hospitals.

6. Following guidelines issued vide order dated 06/11/2001 will however, remain in force for reimbursement of payment of the expenses incurred on the medical treatment of Freedom Fighters and their spouses.

- a) Freedom Fighters are required to submit their claims (in triplicate) in the prescribed application form with Essentiality Certificates of the competent Authority duly countersigned by the Medical Supdt. of the concerned hospital. The Rubber Stamp of the Dr./Medical Supdt. should bear the name of Hospital & Designation of the signing authority along with the verified cash memo/bills, prescription slips/OPD Card/discharge slip etc.
- b) The concerned hospital who have accepted the proposal of direct payment will render the treatment to the Freedom Fighter or his/her spouse only on production of Identity Card/ medical Aid Card issued by this department since 1998.
- c) The concerned hospitals are required to submit their bills to the Principal Secretary (GAD) (in triplicate) bearing the signature of pensioners along with the photo copy of the Identity Card/Medical Aid Card of the Freedom Fighter with essentiality Certificate (specimen enclosed) prescription slips/O.P.D. Card/discharge slip and also give full details of the disease, treatment medicines and test etc.
- d) A certificate from the Freedom Fighter, who is getting medical treatment, will be obtained by the concerned Hospital to the effect that he/she has not crossed the limit of Rupees One Lakh (Now revised to Rupees Two Lakh) during the current financial year meant for direct billing scheme.

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
