C I R C U L A R

The Pr. Secretary(GAD), Govt. of NCT of Delhi, is pleased to announce following policy decisions in r/o sports activities of the Govt. of NCT of Delhi in supersession of all previous circulars in this regard:

- Approval of the HOD/ Competent Authority for each and every proposal whether it is of purchase matter, selection of probable players, selection of final teams, distribution of cash award, inter departmental tournament, TA/ DA for practice camp etc. will be taken at one go, for avoiding unnecessary delay at the actual time of the event.
- Tender for purchase of kit and playing material will be held in the month of April so that purchase can be made in time and the teams shall be provided with kit prior to their participation in the AICS tournaments. Tender for purchasing of sports items should be for two years with the provision of extension of further one year on the same rates terms & conditions. The participating players should wear the sport shirt which should bear the distinct identity of Delhi.
- The manager and coach of each team will be provided with kit at par with that of player and coach will also be provided with playing material. In case Manager and Coach are amongst the players, they will not be given additional kit. Common shoes and other common items will be provided to the teams every year. Playing materials like Badminton, Football, Lawn Tennis and Table Tennis racquets, Cricket bats and other technical items etc. (meant for that particular game) will be given once in every two years. Besides there are games for which specific shoes are required. In such cases specific shoes will be provided every year instead of common shoe. These shoes along with other specific playing material will be purchased under Rule 146 of GFR, 2005. The purchase committee under Rule-146 of GFR-2005 for this purpose comprises the following members:

- An advertisement regarding selection trial for probable players for AICS Tournaments will be published in two leading news paper(One Hindi & One English) for the information of the regular employees of Delhi Government. The publication will contain the major points with a mention of web- site which will have all the details.
- Employees will be allowed to participate in the selection trial even without submitting the permission form as a pre-requisite. This will be as an open entry after filling of an entry form available at the selection venue. However, in case of selection they will have to submit the permission letter from the HOD concerned before issuance of order of practice session. If any such player fails to submit the consent of HOD, next player in the merit list will be selected as a probable player. One officer/ official will be allowed to participate in and will be selected for one game only.
- The probable players will be allowed to practice on one working day after lunch and on Saturday from 10 AM onwards for a period of Six month or till the date of AICS tournament whichever is earlier. Exceptions can be made on merit with the approval of competent authority. However, prior to the AICS tournaments the final team selected will be allowed to practice for a maximum of ten days as per circular of the Central Civil Services Cultural & Sports Board. The players will be entitled for TA/DA as per Rules.
- selection committee consisting of the following members will be formed for selection of the probable and final teams for participation in AICS tournaments.

- orders for practice session of probable teams will be Issued by 30th June every year, so that practice will start w.e.f. 01st July of every year to give ample practice time for the teams.


- After completion of each event, the Manager will submit a brief report indicating all aspects of the game.
- Only the person who has complete knowledge of the game or who is a senior or experienced player will be appointed as Coach of the team. The responsibility of the coach will be to correct the techniques of the players and looking at the fitness aspect of the players.
- The responsibility of the manager will be to collect all the information related to participation of the team in the All India Civil Services Tournaments /Local Tournaments and accordingly do the needful. The manager will also look after the welfare of the team and will apprise the concerned authorities of the problems faced by the team in the concerned tournaments. The manager will also submit the tournament report to the authorities of GAD. The shield won by the team will be deposited in Sports Cell, GAD.
- No players / participant will overstay after the tournament is over.
- Only one function will be held for giving cash award for merit in AICS Tournaments and position holders in the inter departmental tournaments.
